Since 1992, money generated by the county's capital improvement sales tax has allowed us to provide quality public health services to the residents of St. Charles County by funding the renovation of the Community Health facility and construction of the new Pet Adoption Center and Recycle Works recycling center. These facilities enable us to maintain a strong public health presence throughout the community.

The April 5<sup>th</sup> ballot initiative, Proposition One, requests lowering the county's capital improvement sales tax from 1/4¢ to 1/5¢ and renewing it at this reduced rate.
