Construction Continues at Health Department

Parking at a premium near building during work

St. Charles County, Missouri – To better serve the citizens of St. Charles County, the Department of Community Health and the Environment is in the process of expanding and renovating its building at 1650 Boone's Lick Road in St. Charles. The department will continue to offer all services as work progresses. However, as with any construction project, residents can expect some minor inconveniences until the task is complete.

For the next few weeks, off-street parking at the health department building will be severely reduced. On-street parking will also be limited. In addition, some entrances to the building will be closed, and visitors will be redirected with signs posted. Unless the need for a birth certificate or immunization is urgent, residents are asked to wait until the end of May when re-paving of the parking lot should be complete. Updates on the status of construction will be provided as work progresses.
