Immunization Clinic Closing Temporarily

No services from April 30-May 5

St. Charles County, Missouri – Due to ongoing building renovations, the St. Charles County Department of Community Health and the Environment will temporarily close its immunization clinic starting Wednesday, April 30. The clinic will reopen on Monday, May 5.

“We understand the burden this places on residents,” said Nancy Duncan, director of the Division of Public Health. “However, we are taking this step now so that we can improve our delivery of services in the future.”
