Take Action!

If temperature is too cold or too warm (above 46°F or below 35°F):

1. Alert your supervisor immediately.
2. Label vaccines "do not use" and leave them in the refrigerator.
3. Adjust the thermostat and check the temperature in 2 hours.
4. Contact your VFC Representative.
5. Record the actions you take on the right.
